Report on Imaginary Library by Keith Bond

- The program offers one book for each child living within the Royalton-Hartland school district, from birth to entering Kindergarten. In order to receive a book, parents must register their child, providing address and age information.
- Several organizations have been asked and have made a financial commitment to support the project. Most of those asked have committed to multiple years. To date, approximately \$2,500 has been committed; however more organizations will be asked.
- The total amount needed to effectively run the program remains a “moving” target, with several factors determining start up and on-going costs.
