Mission Statement

The mission of the Royalton Hartland Community Library is to provide an opportunity for learning, recreation and personal growth for the residents of the community through the resources and personnel of the library.

Vision Statement

To achieve our mission statement, the Royalton Hartland Community Library will:

- Service the broad-based needs of the community by providing those materials and services most wanted and needed for education, recreation and personal growth.
- Place special emphasis on stimulating *young children's interests and appreciation* for reading and learning.
- Combine traditional expertise with changing technology for equal and easy access to library services, materials and facilities.

Library Services

The Royalton Hartland Community Library has identified the following library services as *critical roles in the fulfillment of our Mission and Vision Statements.*

Children's Door to Learning:

- The library will encourage children to develop an interest in reading and learning through services for children.

Popular Materials Library:

- The Royalton Hartland Community Library will feature current, *high-demand interest materials in a variety of formats for our patrons.*

Reference Library:

- The library will actively provide timely, accurate and useful information for our patrons through print and electronic media.

Goals and Objectives

Goal:

Collection development will be based on the needs and interests of our patrons as determined by formal and informal surveys.

Action Plan:

The library will conduct a survey periodically to determine the needs and interests of our patrons.

Goal:

The library will strive to provide access to the most up-to-date materials from a variety of resources.

Action Plan:

The library will actively participate in the NIOGA system, New York State Library, and other on-line telecommunications.

Goal:

The library will provide activities to encourage children and adults to actively participate in the library.

Action Plan:

The library will offer the following:

- Weekly pre-school story hour
- Summer reading and other youth-oriented programs
- School class visits to the library
- Appropriate level reading materials for recreational and educational purposes
- Encourage parents and grandparents to be active “partners” in library events

Goal:

The library will provide patron services utilizing recent technological advances. We will strive to provide these services using the available space in the most efficient manner.

Action Plan:

This will be accomplished by introducing and/or continuing to provide the following services:

- Bar coding of materials
- Updating the computer workstations
- Internet/Wi-Fi access
- Public and internal library access to the library's data base
- Fax machine
- Copy machine
- Tax forms

- Handicap accessibility
- Meeting room for community groups
- Building and grounds modifications as needed

Goal:

The Friends of the Library will provide support to the resources, services and programs of the Library and will promote the Library's presence in the community.

Action Plan:

The Friends of the Library will offer the following:

- Support and a source of volunteers for Library programs and projects
- Periodic used book sales
- Public relations and advocacy
