Publicity & Outreach

We are in the process of setting up the G.I.F.T. (Generate Imagination in Families Today) Project via Nioga. This acts very similarly to the "Little Free Library" model, but instead of "Take a Book Leave a Book" it's just "Take a Book." We will be provided with signage and milk crates for us to put the books. I have requested 6 crates to be put into our community (ideally 2 in the village, 2 in Gasport, 1 in Royalton, 1 in Hartland--but this will depend on which stores and organizations will agree to participate). This program officially starts in July but once we receive our crates we can begin at any time. I have enlisted the Friends to be in charge of this project.
