Due to the May Book Sale and the construction, I have been weeding our collection heavily following standard weeding guidelines. 1,532 books have been removed from our collection between January and May (adult fiction, adult nonfiction 900s, 700s, 600s, picture books, juvenile fiction, juvenile nonfiction 900s & biographies, and young adult fiction).

My reorganization plan for the children's and YA area is complete.

- We now have a "juvenile a/v" section where the J and YA DVDs and audiobooks are all compiled together (formerly the J BIO section)
- The juvenile biographies are at the end of the nonfiction, after the 900s.
- The picture books have been condensed to 2 shelves per case and there is now enough room that all the books may stand up for the spines to be seen.
- The "tiny" books are now on the picture book side of the shelves.
- The historical fiction and mysteries series (American Girl, Dear America, Hardy Boys, Nancy Drew, etc.) have been rehomed to sharing one section near the juvenile fiction.
- The last step is new labels/signs for each of the sections.

We are hoping this will result in greater circulation for all of these sections.
