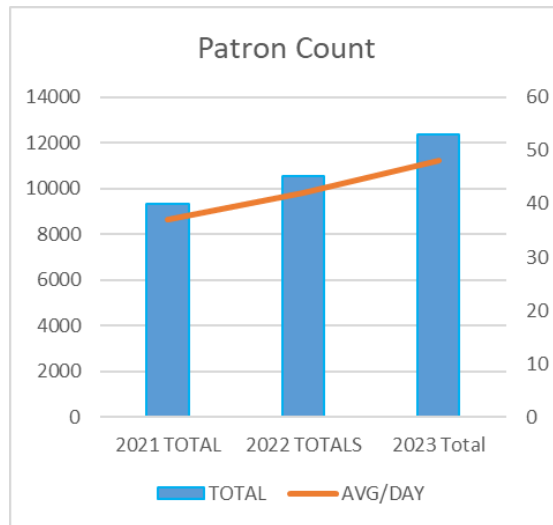


Buildings & Grounds

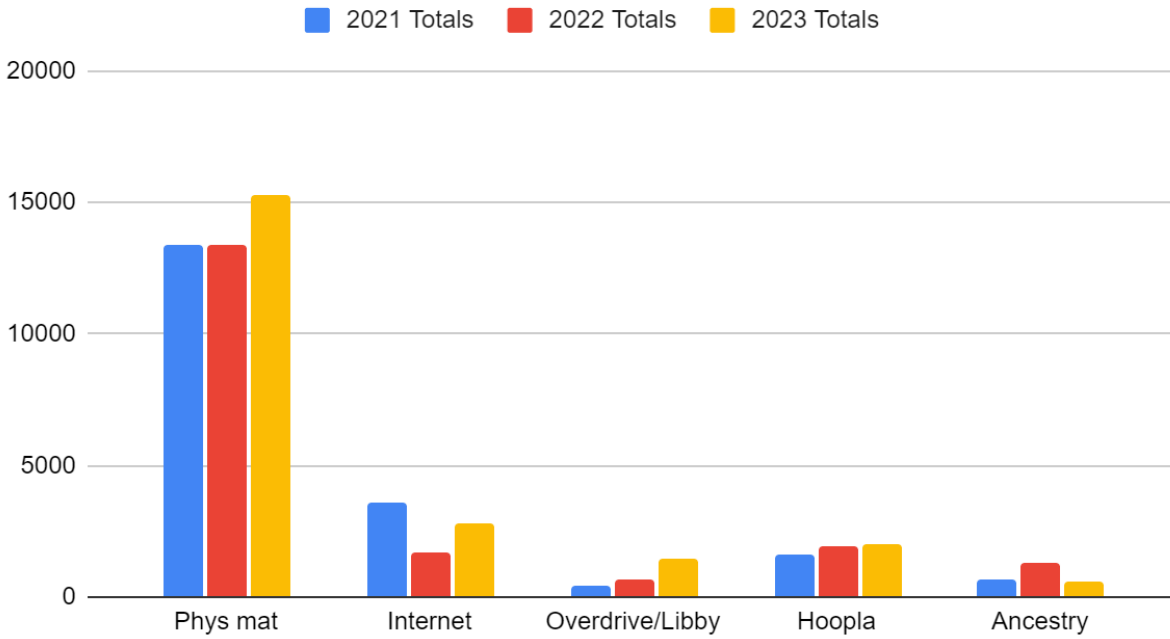

- June 10: The remaining portion of the FY 23-24 school taxes check was picked up to be deposited.

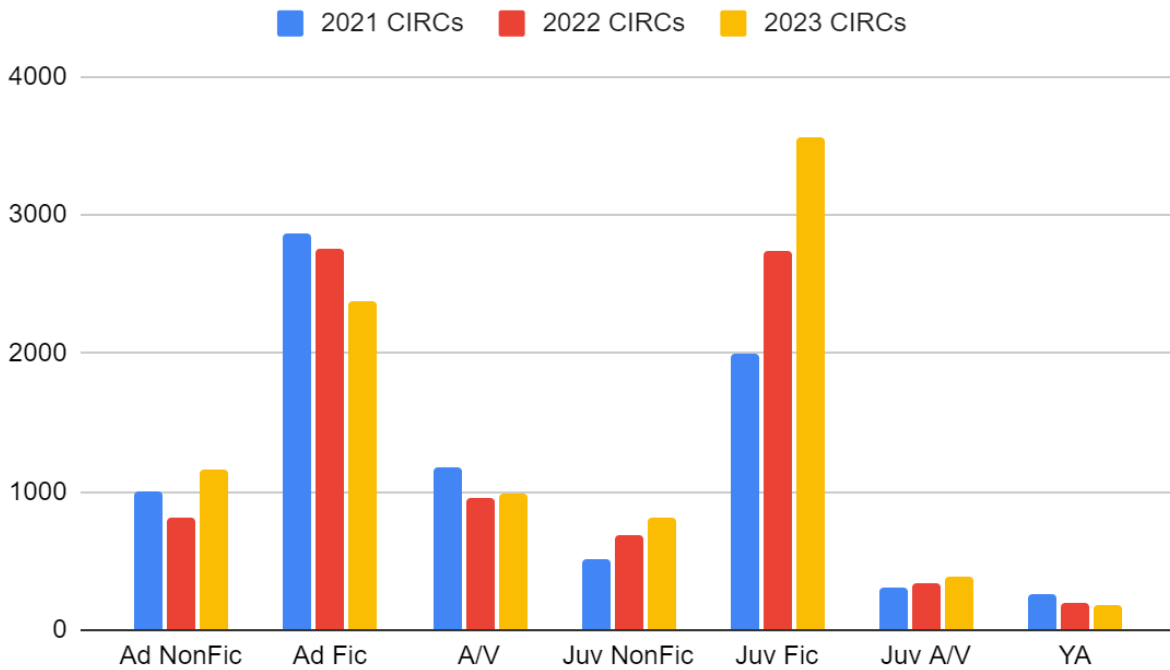
